

# LACOMBE CURLING CLUB – SENIORS COMPETITIVE LEAGUE WEDNESDAY AM RULES AND REGULATIONS (REVISED – FEB 2016)

1. CCA rules in effect, unless otherwise stipulated below.
2. Four rock “Free Guard Zone” in effect.
3. “FORMAT”: a round robin shall be played, contingent upon number of teams entered
4. POINTS AWARDED:
  - a. Regular league games, tied games remain tied. One (1) point per team.
  - b. Winning teams in round robin receive two (2) points; losing team zero (0).
5. REGULAR LEAGUE GAME PAYOUT:
  - a. Winning team shall receive \$10 .
  - b. In the event of a tie, each team shall receive \$5.
  - c. Payouts for league play shall be awarded at conclusion of playoffs..
6. “SPARES”:
  - a. Must be fifty (50) years of age or over before December 31<sup>st</sup> of current year.
  - b. Spares cannot play a higher position than the person missing, but can replace any member of the team during regular league games.
  - c. It is encouraged to use spares from the “spare” list. Skips are responsible for collecting \$5 each game from non-member spares.
  - d. A team may have up to three (3) spares and the game qualifies for points during regular league play.
7. “MISSED GAMES”:
  - a. Every attempt shall be made to make up a postponed game. If at the end of regular league play, the game has not been played, the team which originally cancelled shall forfeit, and the points shall be award to the opposition. (*revised 10/2014*)
  - b. The Curling Club Manager must be notified of cancelled or re-scheduled games (403-782-6277).
8. “PLAYOFF POSITION DETERMINATION”
  - a. If two (2) teams are tied in points at the end of the regular league play for the last position in the “A” division playoff, the team who won between the two teams shall advance to “A”.
  - b. If three (3) teams are tied in points at the end of the regular league play, and one of those teams lost to both the other teams, that team shall be placed in “B” division; and the other two (teams) will revert to rule #8a for placing.
  - c. Should one team have not lost to the other two, the team with the most wins will advance. Should there still be a tie, rule #8a will be in effect.

## PLAYOFF RULES

Following the completion of the regular league play, the six (6) teams with the most points will play off in the “A” division, the remainder competing in the “B” division. ONLY “A” division teams are eligible to receive the club championship jackets or any other award that may be given by the curling club. The “A” division will play for \$30 per game; the “B” division will play for \$20 per game.

1. A five (5) game playoff shall be played in both “A” and “B” division, in a round robin format.
2. Should there be a tie in points between two (2) teams for first place after the round robin, the team who won between the two (2) teams will be the winner.
3. Should there be three (3) teams tied, and one of those teams lost to both the other two (2) teams, that team would fall out, and the other teams would refer to playoff rule #2.
4. In the event of a tie game, an extra end (s) will be played to determine a winner.
5. A maximum of two (2) spares are allowed during playoffs, and MUST be members of Lacombe Curling Club, or from “Seniors Competitive League” spare list.  
Feb. 17, 2016: Spares from the Superleague cannot play higher than Second.
6. Actual scores must be recorded in all playoff games, and may be used to determine placings for all teams.
