COVID-19 (Coronavirus)

Information update

At the Lacombe Curling Club we are aware of the concerns of the Coronavirus. Our facility and all scheduled events at this time will still proceed. We are taking the following precautions and will continue to update and inform all facility users as more information becomes available.

1. Don't attend if you feel sick
2. Follow recommended hand washing protocols
3. Don't shake hands to start the game
4. Rock handles will be wiped down with antibacterial wipes & ones will be available on ice
5. Hand sanitizer will be available in the facility
6. Information posters from Alberta health will be on display in our facility
7. Lounge staff and housekeeping staff have been made alert of the extra necessary precautions that can be implemented

We do acknowledge the latest update from the Government of Alberta asking organizers to cancel any events that have more than 250 attendees or any event that has more than 50 attendees and expects to have international participants, involves critical infrastructure staff, seniors, or other high-risk populations. We feel that we do not meet these criteria therefore, we feel comfortable proceeding with the above risk mitigation protocols we have implemented. We will also be following the lead from the City of Lacombe. If they decide to close access to the facility, we will follow.
