#### A Note about Ice Conditions

Two things that we can all do to help keep our curling ice in great condition is to replace your gripper and remember the carpet is not for cleaning your broom. The general rule of thumb is to replace your gripper every year if you curl once a week. This also helps to prevent slips and injuries. We will have an assortment of grippers and replacement brush heads available in the pro shop.

#### **Curling Dues**

Curling fees will remain the same as last year. All fees will be due at time of registration. Payment can be made your first night of league curling. A one week grace period will be granted for those who forget on week one. This makes all fees due by November 1st. A \$50 late fee will apply to unpaid fees after November 1st.
