Presidents Message

Another curling season is just around the corner. On behalf of the executive, I would like to invite you all back for another year of fun and fellowship. Thank you to those who helped out the club either by volunteering or with monetary donations. The club received approximately \$47,000 in government pandemic grants, and with our members donations, we are showing a loss of approximately \$18,000.

The executive passed a motion to replace the sound system throughout the entire facility last fall. This work was completed in the winter and we received a grant from the City/County of Lacombe for \$15,000 to help pay for the new system.

We are happy to have signed Darren Moulding, Brier Champion, on again as our head ice technician, and Leah Goodey as the Facility and Lounge Manager.

Restriction Exemption Program

The executive has voted in favor of implementing the Restriction Exemption Program in order for us to go ahead with a curling season. I would like to thank you for your understanding and cooperation last season, as we dealt with many unknowns, and continue to again this season. Under this program, anyone 18 years of age and older that wishes to enter the curling club for any reason, will be required to show proof of vaccination, a negative Covid-19 test within 72 hours of accessing the facility, or documentation of a medical exemption. You may also be asked for proof of I.D. Youth aged 12-17 are not required to show proof of vaccination if they are actively participating in sport. Youth under the age of 12 may access the facility without proof of vaccination. As always, please be respectful and kind to the person selected to check the proof of vaccine.

Masks will need to be worn in common areas, but may be removed while curling as well as when you are seated in the upstairs lounge.
